1. WHAT IS PUPIL PREMIUM?

- 1.1 Pupil Premium is additional funding intended to support our pupils on or who have received Free School Meals in the last six years, pupils whose parents are in the armed forces and young people who are living in care. - 1.2 The Pupil Premium Grant has been used to meet the Secondary School's aims through the support of pupils from disadvantaged groups in order to close the gap in achievements between them and other groups.

HIGH IMPACT – More than a quarter of a grade improvement in outcomes on average.

MEDIUM IMPACT - More than between +0.1 and +0.25 grade improvement in outcomes on average.

LOW IMPACT – Less than +0.1 improvement in grades on average.

7-11	SDC and 9C	£95,139	Small setting for pupils who will benefit from either nurture in year 9 or intensive intervention for behaviour for learning in all year groups.	HIGH IMPACT: All pupils avoided Permanent Exclusion last year. 11 out of 12 pupils in the 9c class have returned to the mainstream.
10-11	Alternative Provision	£55,315	Supports pupils in challenging circumstances to be successful in a different educational setting.	HIGH IMPACT: Year 11 students attained a pass grade in GCSE Maths and English.
11	Year 11 consolidation lessons	£53,500	Provide materials, support and guidance to raise achievement in English, maths & science.	HIGH IMPACT: 86% of cohort achieved 4+ in English and maths. 79.5% of PP pupils achieved 4+ which is 10% higher than the previous year.
	Pastoral Group	£700	Breakfast, encourages early attendance to morning revision sessions.	LOW IMPACT: Before school tutoring curtailed due to school closure.
11	Pastoral Group	£21,000	Literacy teacher salary to work with pupils with the greatest pastoral needs to ensure that they have the support necessary to achieve good GCSE passes including English and Maths.	MEDIUM IMPACT: The school closure which directly impacted on this resource.
7-11	Art therapy	£12,500	Art therapy teacher salary to work with pupils with the greatest pastoral needs to ensure that they have the support to access the curriculum.	HIGH IMPACT: 71% of the students in KS3 who received this intervention improved their emotional resilience, attitude and behaviour engagement.
11	Pastoral Group	£12,644	Senior teachers for intervention support & supervision to achieve good GCSE passes including English and Maths.	HIGH IMPACT: 86% of cohort achieved 4+ in English and maths. 79.5% of PP pupils achieved 4+ which is 10% higher than the previous year.

7-9	Enrichment	£55,000	Develop wider educational and life skills.	MEDIUM IMPACT: Previously 65% of pupils 'enjoy' or 'really enjoy' enrichment activities, however school closure prevented assessment.
7	7C and 8C nurture classes	£31,500	Nurture class delivering full curriculum at Key Stage 3 in a small setting.	HIGH IMPACT: 86% increased by an entry level between July 19 and Dec in English and 71% did the same in maths.
7-10	Activities week	£30,000	Provides opportunities for pupils to have enriching experiences and develop new skills and interests.	LOW IMPACT: Cancelled due to school closure
11	English tutoring	£26,766	Apply PiXL 'Diagnosis, Therapy & Testing' model to raise achievement in English.	HIGH IMPACT: A fundamental element of the PiXL inspired Diagnose, Therapy & Testing programme. The PP cohort achieved 11.49 points in English GCSE bucket.
11	Maths tutoring	£16,766	Apply PiXL 'Diagnosis, Therapy & Testing' model to raise achievement in maths.	HIGH IMPACT: A fundamental element of the PiXL inspired Diagnose, Therapy & Testing programme. The PP cohort achieved 10.43 points in Maths GCSE bucket.
7-11	Attendance officer	£15,000	Support the attendance of all pupils in the Academy.	MEDIUM IMPACT: Whole cohort full year of attendance not available due to closure in March. At that point attendance was tracking above national figures.
10-11	French and Spanish tutors	£12,625	Tutors provide support in small groups for students whose language skills are below their targeted levels.	HIGH IMPACT: 81% pupils achieved 4+ in Spanish GCSE and 100% in French GCSE.

7-8	Mathematics Mastery	£4,500	Mathematics Mastery programme for KS3 students to develop deeper understanding of mathematical concepts.	MEDIUM IMPACT: All Year 7 and 8 maths teachers undertook weekly training sessions for the whole year. The new curriculum needs full judgement post KS3 ISEB assessment which was cancelled due to school closure.
11	Pre-Public Exams in maths and English	£1,125	Develop students study and exam skills to ensure success at GCSE.	HIGH IMPACT: 86% of students achieved a 4 or better in English and maths GCSE.
	CAHMS therapy	£9,000	Therapy support for students.	HIGH IMPACT: The support provided triage services to our pupils including therapy which was very beneficial.
11	Careers Advisor support	£5,500	Support pupils with career planning and post 16 pathways to provide motivation.	HIGH IMPACT: 98.8% of pupil premium students studying in SMMA have a place in further education.
