Year 6 School Sleepover and Day trip to Southend

Dear Parent/Carer

Next Thursday will be the day our Year 6s finish their 'fake SATS' and get to spend some time celebrating all their hard work. This celebration will be in the form of a school sleepover and day trip to Southend-on-Sea, including access to rides at Adventure Island Theme Park, lunch is provided, the children may want to bring additional food in case they are hungry throughout the day.

Children will need collecting from school at the usual time (3:15-3:30), go home to get things ready and then return at 6:00pm with everything they need for the night and the following day trip to Southend. **If your child is not sleeping over they will need to be collected at 9.00 pm.**

For the sleepover they will need:

- ✓ pyjamas,
- ✓ change of clothes for the next day
- ✓ sleeping bag/duvet
- ✓ sheet,
- ✓ pillow,
- ✓ toothbrush & toothpaste
- ✓ toiletries, deodorants etc

They can bring a drink in a plastic bottle and a small snack (**no nuts**) to eat at some point in the evening, and a comfort toy if they want.

We will be setting up tents in the hall for the children to sleep in 3-4 per tent, which will be set up on gym mats for comfort. These groups will be decided in class. We will be getting takeaway pizzas for their dinner.

On the Friday morning the children will have breakfast (croissants, toast, cereal and juice) and **board the coach at 8:30am.**

For the day trip, the children will need:

- ✓ daypack
- ✓ refillable water bottle
- ✓ sun protection and cap (if hot)
- ✓ a light raincoat
- ✓ Some pocket money to spend (no more than £20)



They will be leaving Southend at 4:30PM and the estimated time of arrival back at school will be 6:15PM, but we will try and keep you updated on this at the time. **All children need to be collected by an adult.**

Due to safeguarding reasons, we would like to ask the children **not** to bring mobile phones or devices that have access to the internet. They may bring digital cameras, or MP3-type devices to listen to music (if anyone has a Walkman, that would be epic!). We will supply some cameras for the children to use in their groups, too.
