Practise identifying them and explaining their effect in any fiction text (you could use your reading book!). ● Use your Academy Diary and classwork to revise 'What? How? Why?' analysis. ● Practise fiction writing in timed conditions. Use www.pobble365.com for a daily creative writing challenge. ● Complete any practice ISEB papers your English teacher gives you.

Alternatively, search for the relevant lists and create a new bank. ● Use BBC Bitesize KS3 German to revise key grammar topics. Some topics we cover for the ISEB are included in the BBC Bitesize GCSE list. There are also other helpful free online websites like the Language Gym. ● Consider purchasing the KS3 CGP Revision Guide and Workbook to support your revision.
Spanish	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Sentence builders (in your book) ● Memrise: https://www.memrise.com/ 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Go over your sentence builders in your book (shared online too). ● Practise writing from memory, paying particular attention to verbs. ● Use Memrise 10 minutes a day to revise Y7 and Y8 topics.
